
Please provide copies of the following government records:

1. District policies regarding the selection or acquisition of books for student circulation in the high school library.
2. District policies regarding the removal of books or materials from the high school library including policies outlining the complaint process and/or policies outlining the District's review of the books or materials in question.
3. Meeting minutes from the Rancocas Valley Regional High School Board of Education meeting held on Tuesday, May 4, 2010.
4. Complaints received by the District regarding the book Revolutionary Voices: A Multicultural Queer Youth Anthology.
5. District policies pertaining to the advisory committee that recently reviewed the book Revolutionary Voices: A Multicultural Queer Youth Anthology, including policies reflecting the establishment, membership, membership selection, and powers of the advisory committee.
6. Documents reflecting the names, titles or positions of the members of the aforementioned advisory committee.
7. Meeting minutes from the meetings of the aforementioned advisory committee when it reviewed the book Revolutionary Voices: A Multicultural Queer Youth Anthology.
8. Documents reflecting the curriculum committee's final recommendation made to the entire school board to remove the book Revolutionary Voices: A Multicultural Queer Youth Anthology from the high school library.

If you determine that any portion of the requested materials is exempt from release, we request that you redact the portion that you believe exempt and provide us with copies of the remaining, non-exempt portions. Also, if any or part of this request is denied, please send us a letter describing the material and listing the specific exemption(s) on which you rely. If the cost of copies for this request does not exceed \$25, proceed without further approval and send me an invoice with the records. Otherwise, please advise me of the costs before filling the request so that we can discuss arrangements.
