This letter constitutes the response of the Office of the Governor to the above-referenced OPRA request, which requested:

I seek copies of:

- 1) All correspondence, electronic and otherwise, between Gov. Christie and Roger E. Ailes. Ailes is the chairman of Fox News.
- 2) All correspondence, electronic and otherwise, between Richard Bagger and Ailes.
- 3) All entries in Gov. Christie's call logs indicating telephone calls to or from Ailes.
- 4) Any written messages for Gov. Christie indicating telephone calls from Ailes.
- 5) All entries in Gov. Christie's schedule indicating meetings, meals, or visits of any kind with Ailes.
- 6) All entries in Bagger's call logs indicating telephone calls to or from Ailes.
- 7) Any written messages Bagger indicating telephone calls from Ailes.


The time frame for this request is January 19, 2010 to present.

Please be advised that the records you are seeking, if they exist, would be exempt from disclosure pursuant to OPRA based upon the executive privilege and well-settled case law. North Jersey Newspapers Co. v. Passaic County Bd. of Freeholders, 127

N.J. 9 (1992); Gannett N.J. Partners v. Middlesex, 379 N.J. Super. 205 (App. Div. 2005); Shearn v. Office of the Governor, GRC Complaint No. 2003-53 (February 2004). As such, this office will not be providing any records pursuant to your request.
